This conference promises to be a gathering of some of the most respected voices in Shroud research.

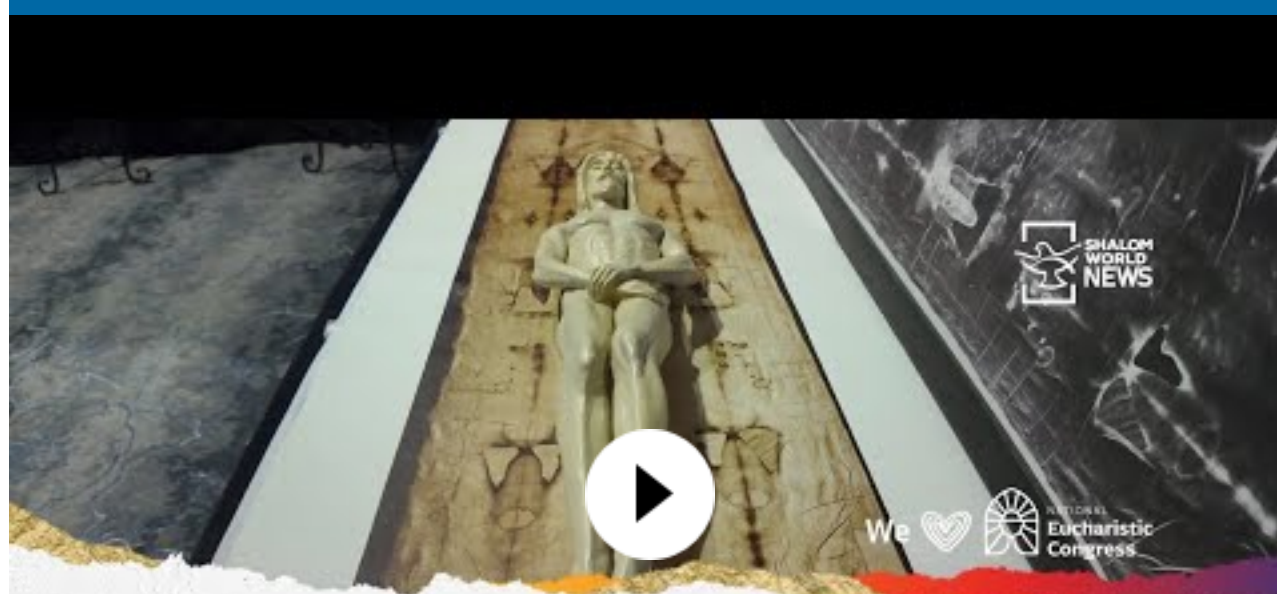

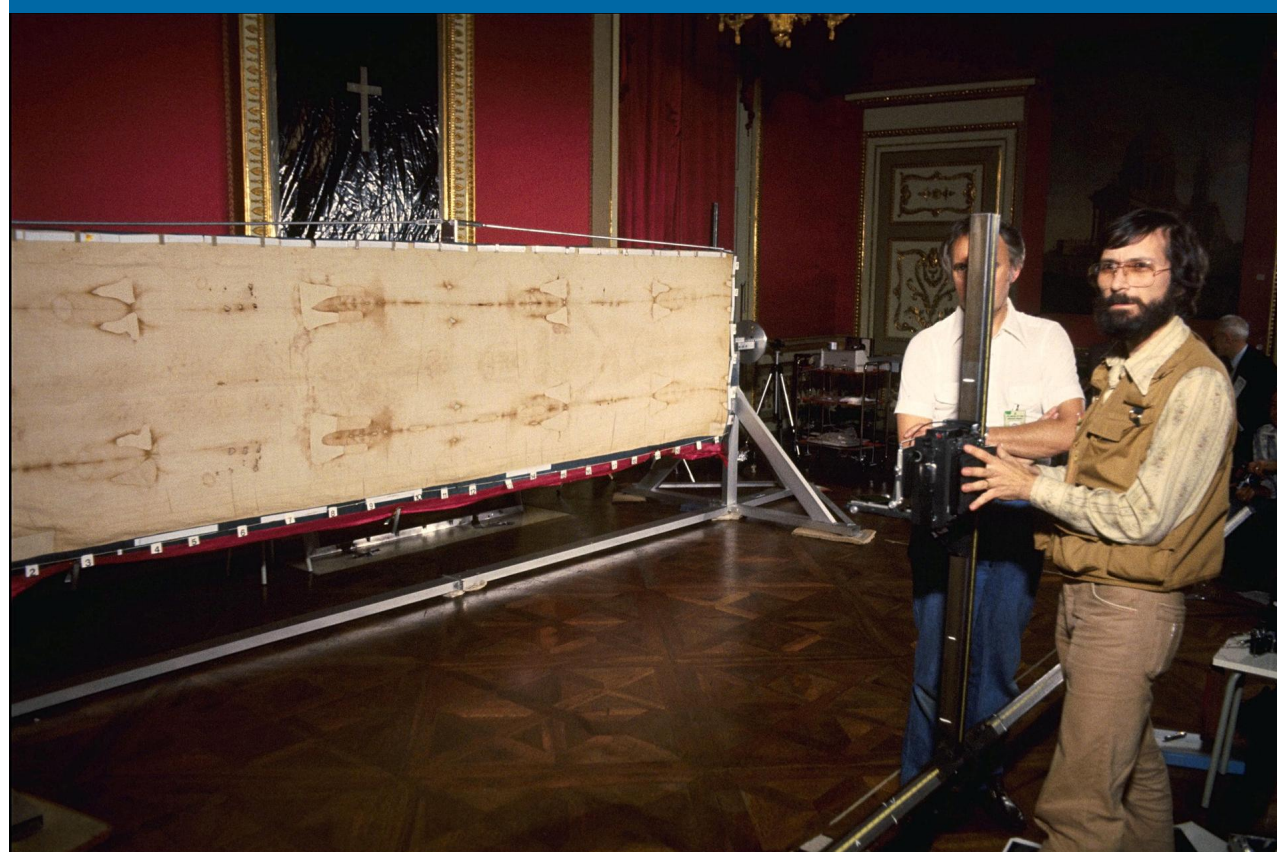

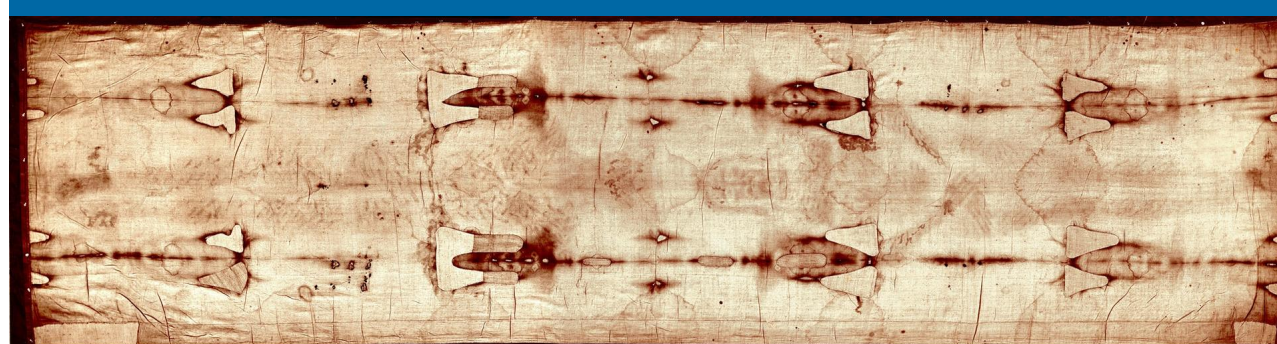
